Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we were really pleased to welcome to our school the inspirational speaker Bart Gee. Bart has a rare physical disability called Arthrogryposis which means that he has weak muscles and stiff joints. After Bart was born, doctors said he would never walk and may not ever have the strength to be able to sit up independently, and he would have a bleak outlook to life. Bart spoke to the whole school about his life growing up, and explained how he has overcome some of the many challenges he has faced, and faces every day.

Following that our Year 1 - 6 pupils had workshops with Bart where they had a taste of what life with Bart's particular physical challenges can be like. The pupils were in awe when Bart showed them videos of his triathlon achievements, and then he wowed us all with his beautiful piano playing.

The overall message, and theme of the afternoon, was "Turning disability into possibility" and Bart's message to all of our children was that hard is still possible, difficult is still possible, challenging is still possible, so don't give up on things, but persevere to find the way that you can learn or accomplish something that you want to do.

At the end of the afternoon it was wonderful to hear how inspired the children were by Bart, and how much they had enjoyed his talk. I hope that they shared some of what they learnt and reflected on with you at home.









As we move into the Second Week of Advent, where we light the candle of Peace, I wish all of you the peace and joy of Christ in your lives, and hopefully the chance to find a small slice of time for yourselves in this busy season.
