Dear Parents and Carers,

Our first week back after the half term break has been a lovely one. We are now in the liturgical season of Lent, with Ash Wednesday falling in the holiday, and the children have been thinking about the meaning of Lent and how we will be trying especially hard to focus on prayer and giving to others.

Our Year 6 class, Skylarks, are leading the traditional Lent Fundraising Stalls which begin next week for a month. See below for more details shared by Year 6. All fundraising is going to the Good Shepherd Appeal by Caritas (the charity of the Diocese of Shrewsbury).

This week we have also established our Mini Vinnie faith group, and we will be meeting for the first time next week to discuss plans for Lent and Easter.

Our theme this term is character strengths, and the children will be engaged in a range of activities and looking at scripture where they will consider and explore this theme. This Sunday the parish welcomes pupils in our Year 4 enrolling on the First Reconciliation Sacramental Programme.

On Wednesday this week I welcomed a number of headteachers from around Warrington to St Monica's, where they enjoyed a tour of our school and saw the learning taking place in classes. They were wowed by the children's hard-working, engaging and purposeful learning environments, and remarked on how clear it was that the children love to learn here at St Monica's - a fantastic endorsement of how strong the mission is living out in our pupils!
