

### Information about Home School Agreements

The Governors of our school have a statutory responsibility to publish a Home School Agreement and associated parental declaration (Ref: School Standards and Framework Act 1998).

#### Home School Agreement

Parents/ carers and children are requested to sign the declaration to show that they have read, understand and accept the contents of the Home School Agreement. This is not a legally binding document and cannot be enforced. However, it aims to engage parents, children and the school in a common agreement about respective roles and responsibilities

The invitation to parents/carers to sign the declaration is extended only to parents/carers of pupils on roll at the school.

The signing of the declaration **is not** a condition of admission into school nor is admission into school based on the likelihood of a parent signing the declaration.

The agreement will be issued to parents/ carers of new intake children (either in YR or in other classes), and children going into Y3, unless a review requires that it is re-issued to all parents.

Prior to adopting a reviewed agreement there will be consultation with all parents/ carers of registered pupils at our school.

This agreement will be reviewed every three years.
